

Education Sector Logon Upgrade – Factsheet for School Stakeholders

ESL upgrade

The *Education Sector Logon (ESL)*¹ is being upgraded over the period to June 2018. There will be no change to the username, password, or security questions for a user's *Education Sector Logon* account.



Users will experience an updated logon page as well as improved self-service, including for password reset and username reminder, which will reduce the need to call the Education Service Desk.

Delegated authorisers in schools

The upgraded *Education Sector Logon* will provide improved functionality for delegated authorisers² in schools.

They will authorise their school's users directly within ESL instead of making requests through the *Education sector logon Provisioning Application (EPA)*, so the set-up of new user accounts and most changes to users' roles will take effect immediately, whereas through EPA it can take up to three days.

¹ The Education Sector Logon (ESL) has also previously been known as the Education Sector Authentication and Authorisation (ESAA) system.

² School authorisers require delegated authority from Principals and are currently referred to as EPA authorisers.

Delegated authorisers in schools will also be able to assist their users to initiate a password reset without needing to call the Education Service Desk, improving user experience and saving time for teachers.

Support portal

An improved support portal for the *Education Sector Logon* has already been implemented at <http://services.education.govt.nz/education-sector-logon>.

Feedback from users

A reference group with members drawn from the education workforce including delegated authorisers from a wide range of schools has had input into the upgrade. Their response has been positive, including comments such as “it’s a step up from EPA” and that the upgrade is “within the comfort zone” for delegated authorisers.

Screenshots

The following screenshots give a side-by-side comparison of the current EPA and the new ESL authorisation functionality. This illustrates the similarity of the two systems while supporting the new functionality of the upgraded ESL.

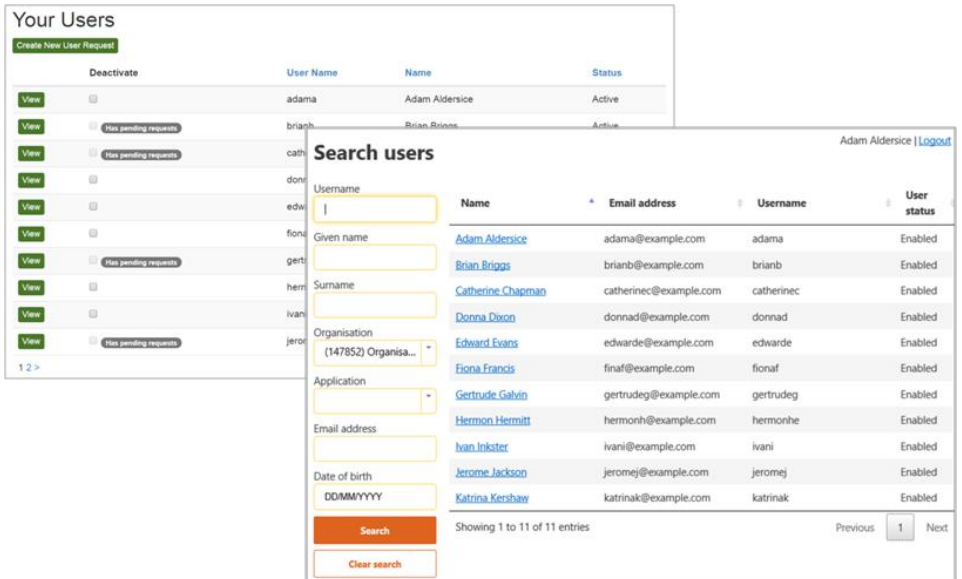
